



A Call to Purity Weekend Session Overviews Women Audience

Session 1: A Personal Testimony

The weekend begins with an intimate session featuring a personal testimony from the Pure Life Ministries Women's Counseling Director, Rose Colón. The audience will hear and be able to identify with the speaker as she describes her life being affected by the sexual sin of her husband. She will describe how the LORD used her husband sin to bring her into a closer intimacy with Jesus.

This session will create a comfortable atmosphere for the audience that will encourage ladies to break-down walls and have an open heart to what God wants to do in their hearts throughout the weekend.

Session 2: Purity Today as Women

Is there a need for Christian women to walk in purity in today's culture? It is possible to live pure in this age when Jesus is our only passion? The Bible clearly answers, YES! This session will explain why purity is important to God. The session will also illustrate how purity isn't just the outward actions of women, but rather an inner life that begins with devotion to God. Women will see their need for a pure heart.

The session also exposes the spirit of this world and how worldliness compromises purity. Listeners will be challenged to take an inventory of what goes on inside their hearts. At the end of session, the audience will discover God's heart and how he yearns to be intimate with His beloved bride.

Session 3: Walking In Purity

The final women's only session encompasses an in-depth look of practical ways women can walking in purity. This includes:

- Understanding your temptation as women
- Identify circumstances that you're likely to be tempted to sin as women
- Identify the reason(s) for the temptation.
- Focus on knowing Jesus in a more intimate way
- Learning to control your thinking
- Learning to live a life that glorifies the Lord

Session 4: Understanding True Repentance

The final session brings the men and women together and concludes by teaching true repentance: what it is, how it unfolds, its benefits, and how a man can have it for himself. By contrasting the lives of two biblical characters, Saul and David, the session distinguishes the difference between godly sorrow and worldly sorrow. The speaker will also walk the audience through the powerful progression found in the Beatitudes.

We will take an in-depth examination of the following:

- Poor in Spirit: Being truly broken over sin
- Meekness: A surrendering of the will to God
- Fruit of Repentance
